

Colored Pencils on Wooden Panel Project

Using Tombow's Recycled Colored Pencils on a wood surface requires no special technique and provides stunning results!

MATERIALS:

- Tombow Recycled Colored Pencils
- Tombow Drawing Pencil 2H
- Tombow Colored Pencil Eraser
- Tombow MONO Twin Permanent Black Marker
- Turquoise and White Acrylic paint
- Acrylic Clear Medium
- Acrylic Varnish, matte
- ½" Flat Paintbrush
- Background Stencil
- Rubber Stamps
- Black Inkpad
- Sanding Pad



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using the **Tombow 2H Drawing Pencil**, sketch in your drawing.
2. Add in the background around your sketch by painting in a mixture of ½ acrylic paint and ½ clear medium to create your glaze.
3. When the paint is dry sand to fade and distress along the edges.
4. Use the **Tombow MONO Twin Marker** to add deep shadows and crisp details within your sketch.
5. Use the **Tombow Recycled Colored Pencils** to add color and the **Tombow Colored Pencil Eraser** to remove unwanted color and bring back highlights.
6. Coat the wooden panel with clear varnish and let dry completely, Add in the stamped and stenciled background for a mixed media effect



7. Use the **Tombow Colored Pencil Eraser** to soften and distress.
