

Mixed Media Moon Art

This beautiful night inspired mixed media piece of art is easy to achieve with Tombow's Water Soluble Yo-I Crayons!

MATERIALS:

- Tombow Water Soluble Yo-I Crayons
- Tombow Drawing Pencil
- Tombow MONO Twin Permanent Marker
- Tombow MONO Eraser
- Water Brush
- Tombow Dual Brush Pens
- Tombow MONO Multi Liquid Glue
- Tombow Fudenosuke Brush Pen
- Clearsnap Design Foils

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. The first step is to sketch the Moon using **Tombow Drawing Pencils**.
2. Line your sketch with the fine tip of the **Tombow Mono Twin Permanent Marker** and erase pencil marks with the **Tombow MONO Eraser**.
3. Use the bright **Tombow Yo-i Crayon** lightly on the watercolor paper and use a water brush to spread the color.
4. For the eyes and lips use the **Tombow Dual Brush Pens**.
5. Then use the **Tombow Mono Multi Liquid Glue** to make dots, let it dry and then used Clearsnap Designer Foils.
6. Write in stars with a **Tombow Dual Brush Pen** and add the smaller ones with the **Tombow Fudenosuke Brush Pen Soft Tip**.
