

## Subtractive Stamping: Family Home

*This fun new technique is made by removing the print of the cardstock and replacing it with the bright colors from Tombow's Recycled Colored Pencils!*

### MATERIALS:

- Tombow Recycled Colored Pencils, Brightset
- Tombow Colored Pencil Eraser
- Tombow Drawing Pencil B
- Tombow Adhesive Runner
- Square Cards and Envelopes
- Kraft Tissue Paper
- Gray and Black Stamp Pads



### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Stamp your image with the gray stamp pad and using the **Tombow Colored Pencil Eraser**, remove the top layer of printed paper to reveal the white paper underneath.
2. Re stamp your image in black (don't worry if you are a little off!)
3. Edge the panel with **Tombow Recycled Colored Pencils**.
4. Adhere embellishments around your stamped image with **Tombow Dot Adhesives** (we used a wooden heart)
5. Fill in your stamped image with **Tombow Recycled Colored Pencils**, leaving white for highlights.
6. Use the **Tombow Drawing Pencil B** to create a shadow effect around your stamped image.
